

"My creation for the village" Article #1 May 26,2023 by Peppe Apuleo

The decision to create these columns stems from the request of some friends and fellow villagers. In this first article dedicated to "my creations for the village" we will see the creation of an arch structure to be inserted in an environment of a historic city center.

This arched structure was made from high density XPS polystyrene with scrap pieces recycled from the waste bin.


Below you will find photos that show the realization step by step.

Materials used for the construction, polystyrene, hot glue, acrylic colors, grass, stones, soil, decorations such as lampposts, amphorae, characters, etc.




Choice and selection of XPS polystyrene material in different sizes and thicknesses. The shape of the pieces is random.

Photos #2 and #3 draw, engrave and shape the bow. I cut the polystyrene with the Proxxon Thermocut 230/E machine.



selection and cutting of polystyrene parts for the construction of the arch.

place, assemble and glue the parts.

with a pencil draw lines that simulate stones.



repeat the operation on the whole structure in a random way. The dimensions of the stones to be made are random

engrave the polystyrene with a hot engraver for polystyrene creating the shape of the stones.

engrave the entire structure according to the previously traced design, add a base by gluing it to the structure and engrave the flooring, shape the stones at random according to your imagination.

Once all the incision operations have been completed, apply one or more coats of white acrylic primer and leave to dry thoroughly. This operation completes the construction phase.

With the black acrylic colour, start the painting operations.
